According to research firm Berg Insight, the number of dedicated devices for home health monitoring with integrated cellular connectivity increased from 0.73 million in 2011 to about 1.03 million in 2012, and is projected to grow at a compound annual growth rate of 46.3 percent to 7.1 million in 2017.
